

RESOLUTION NO. 18 – 05**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
GROVELAND COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
(Govt. Code Section 21156)**

WHEREAS, the Groveland Community Services District (hereinafter referred to as Agency) is a contracting agency of the Public Employee's Retirement System, and

WHEREAS, the Public Employee's Retirement Law requires that a contracting agency determine whether an employee of such agency in employment in which he is classified as a local safety member is disabled for purposes of the Public Employee's Retirement Law and whether such disability is "industrial" within the meaning of such law, and

WHEREAS, an application for Industrial Disability Retirement of Steven Williamson employed by the Agency in the position of Fire Chief has been filed with the Public Employees Retirement System, and

WHEREAS, the Groveland Community Services District has reviewed the medical and other evidence relevant to such alleged disability.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Groveland Community Services District find and determine and it does hereby find and determine that Steven Williamson is incapacitated within the meaning of the Public Employees Retirement Law for performance of his duties in the position of Fire Chief.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Groveland Community Services District find and determine and it does hereby find and determine that such disability is a result of injury or disease arising out of and in the course of employment.

Neither said Steven Williamson nor the agency Groveland Community Services District has applied to the Workers Compensation Appeals Board for a determination pursuant to Section 21166 whether such disability is industrial.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the member was, or will be separated from his employment in the position of Fire Chief after expiration of his rights under Section 21164, Government Code, effective August 1, 2005 and that no dispute as to the expiration of such leave rights is pending. His last day on pay status is August 1, 2005.

There is not a possibility of third party litigation.



Neither said Steven Williamson nor the agency Groveland Community Services District has applied to the Workers Compensation Appeals Board for a determination pursuant to Section 21166 whether such disability is industrial.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the member was, or will be separated from his employment in the position of Fire Chief after expiration of his rights under Section 21164, Government Code, effective August 1, 2005 and that no dispute as to the

There is not a possibility of third party liability.

Advanced Disability Pension Payments will not be made.

The primary disabling condition is right knee disablement.
