GCSO Groveland Fire Engine

*Dedicated to emergency response **within** the GCSO boundary*

The GCSO Groveland Fire Engine's primary mission is to provide all-risk emergency response within the GCSO boundary. Operating from the GCSO Groveland Fire Station, the District's fire engine is dedicated to serving GCSO residents, businesses, and visitors, responding to fires, medical emergencies, rescues, traffic collisions, hazardous conditions, and public service calls. When resources are available and assistance is requested, GCSO crews may also respond outside the District through automatic/mutual aid.



Tuolumne County Fire Engine

*Dedicated to emergency response **outside** the GCSO boundary*

The Tuolumne County Engine's primary mission is to provide all-risk emergency response outside the GCSO boundary. Operating from the GCSO Groveland Fire Station under an agreement through June 30, 2027, the County engine serves residential communities, lodging facilities, resorts, and other areas beyond the District. When available and requested, it may also assist within the District through automatic/mutual aid.



CAL FIRE Schedule B Station

Dedicated to wildland fire response within State Responsibility Areas

The CAL FIRE Schedule B station is primarily a state wildland fire resource, focused on fire response, wildfire suppression, and protection of State Responsibility Area lands. When available and not assigned to other incidents, CAL FIRE resources may also assist with medical aids, rescues, traffic collisions, and other local emergencies.



U.S. Forest Service Station

Dedicated to wildland fire response within National Forest lands

The U.S. Forest Service station primarily supports wildland fire response and protection of federal lands within the Stanislaus National Forest. Its resources are focused on wildfire suppression, fuels, and forest protection, but may assist with other emergencies when available through interagency cooperation.
