#### **Operations:**

#### **Emergency Incident Response:**

On November 6<sup>th</sup> Groveland Fire and CAL FIRE units responded to a report of a residential structure fire on Green Valley Circle in Pine Mountain Lake. Upon arriving at scene, there was no smoke or fire visible. The Incident Commander contacted the homeowner where they located an extinguished fire in the heating unit on the roof. Fire crews secured utilities and checked for extension of fire. The homeowner was advised not to use the heating unit until it was serviced and inspected by a professional HVAC company. The cause of the fire is under investigation.

All equipment is in service and available.

- Installed new water meter and backflow on Old Hwy 120.
- Ran Ammonia to AWS for November outage.
- Checked motor leads to 2g Turbine for tightness and omhed motor.
- Diagnosed auto start problem for 2G Turbine. We had a Tellstar employee come on site and they found PLC was in test mode.
- Installed anchor bolts for the Turbine VFD over hang.
- Installed new water meter box for property on Black Rd.
- Flushed water in the Tank 2, 4 and Tank 5 service area.
- Moved Dunn Ct stand by Generator to Tank 2 for Booster pump start up.
- Installed new OSG cell at 2G and brought into service.
- Changed out meters at unit 12 lot 36 & 37. Lot 37 meter stopped registering consumption.
- Opened up Big Creek UV room and prepped for TUD to view system.
- Changed out air relays on the Pall Trailer at 2G.
- Put cut back on water line repair patches at the back gate and the main gate.

## Sewer-

- Weekly Preventative Maintenance Check (PMCS) and Generators Checks at all Lift Stations.
- Cleaned the pressure transducers and floats as needed at all Lift Stations.
- Did odor control at all Lift Stations as needed.
- Chemically cleaned various gravity sewer lines throughout the District.
- Hydro-Flushed various gravity sewer lines throughout the District.
- Prepared and sent in monthly Sewer report to the State.
- Ran the Screw press to waste from the Digester.
- Emptied drying beds and replenished sand when needed.
- Moved pallets of salt to the STP OSG room for Chlorine Generation.
- Sprayed down and cleaned roto room daily.
- When weather permitted we ran irrigation for all spray fields.
- Did daily rounds/weather and Lab for the WWTP.
- Took weekly Bacti Samples of the CCC.
- Repaired LS 16 fence and Gate.
- Ordered new valves for Digester blower number 2.
- Sampled Res. # 2.
- Core drilled and installed bollards for the Bio Solids building. Bollards and pressure treated 2x12 will hold back wet sludge during the winter.
- Pulled Lift Stations pumps and took pictures of all name plates. Will use pictures for quotes and set up files for each Station.
- Changed out UPS batteries at Lift Station 11, 12, 14 and 15.


- Cleaned out gutters and blew off roofs for the Park restroom, Admin building and Highlands pump station.
- Cleaned out drains at Big Creek Treatment Plant.
- Cleaned out STP Generator room.

## Safety & Training-

- Weekly safety meetings.
- Weekly vehicle checks.

## **Major Projects**

- Tied conduit into new blower disconnects for Digester, wired in blower number 1 and checked operation. CPO put blower into service which has helped the Screw Press run more efficiently.
- Finished plumbing in 8" pipe/fittings to the New Booster Pump Skid at Tank 2. Set valve boxes, poured new pad for the control cabinet and set cabinet in place. Cleaned up all debris and brought back to yard.
- Started upper park restroom remodel. Pulled all fixtures and panels out of the Men's side
  and replaced with new. New fixtures required some plumbing changes/modifications.
  Waiting for ADA partition to finish men's side. Pressure washed walls and prepped for
  paint. Cut asphalt going into janitor room for upcoming Park camera/gate electrical
  install.
- Started AWS project. Saw cut asphalt and dug up water main to get OD for pressure transducer saddle. Removed all asphalt and started to dig trenches to bury all exposed water/sample lines for post/pre CCT, Pre/post clear well.
- Installed new 6" check valve and Air release valve at 2G. Employee had to cut and weld in new section of pipe. Cleaned up site and winterized the Turbine.
- Met with District engineer and went over waterline placement for upcoming project in Groveland and BOF.
- Met with the State and did job walk for upcoming Sewer Line replacement project for Groveland and BOF.
