GCSD Board
of Directors

Sets policy and strategic direction; adopts master plan and budgets; establishes service levels; measures organizational performance; approves major contracts; and develops long-term funding strategies



GCSD Management

Implements Board policy and strategic direction; manages day-to-day operations and finances; develops and administers budgets and financial forecasts; ensures service levels and contract compliance; coordinates emergency preparedness and fire prevention; secures grants and funding; implements master plans; coordinates fire, water, sewer, and infrastructure planning, including fire water storage, hydrants, emergency access, and evacuation routes; manages facilities, apparatus, and equipment; and oversees purchasing, accounting, and compliance with applicable laws, regulations, and standards



CAL FIRE

Provides fire suppression, emergency medical response, rescue services, firefighter staffing, training, apparatus operations, and emergency response under the Schedule A contract while maintaining compliance with CAL FIRE operational standards
