

- Completed daily rounds and Lab
- Cleaned out STP OSG unit brine tank
- Fabricated and installed new polymer mixer for the screw press
- · Replaced belts and aligned blower for STP

# **Wastewater Collections Department**


- Completed all Preventative Maintenance Check Sheets (PMCS) at all Lift Stations (weekly)
  - Added degreaser and odor control as needed
- Chemical flushed gravity sewer lines throughout the District for system maintenance
- Inspected and flushed problem manholes
- Hydro flushed multiple gravity lines throughout the District for system maintenance

- Completed Manhole inspections for LS 2 and 16 gravity lines, total of 158 manholes opened and inspected
- Cleaned Lift Stations: 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12
- Checked for I&I during storm events
- Cleaned Twin Pines easement
- Cleaned LS 15 easement of brush
- Performed sewer tie-in on Otter Ct
- Cleaned check valves at L 10

- Performed weekly checks and calibrations on all analyzers at 2G, BC, and AWS
- Performed monthly UV calibrations at 2G and BC

- Replaced UV bulbs at 2G
